

### In The Coliseum



Fr John Audino, FSSP, celebrated his first anniversary of ordination with the *Usus Antiquior* in the Coliseum. 250 people attended.

Originally from the Albany Diocese, he described the Shrine as "the holiest ground in America" and that his vocation was "inspired" here.

Fr Brian Maxwell of the Diocese of Norwich, CT, was main celebrant for St Kateri Feast Day Mass with Fr Giorgio as concelebrant. A longtime friend of



the Shrine, Fr Maxwell was accompanied by Deacons Dan D'Amelio and Douglas Hoffman also of the Norwich Diocese, who served Mass.

Visitor Center sponsored by the Auriesville Council of the Knights of Columbus.

As Father Giorgio spent most of his priesthood in Italy, he was pleased to celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Mount

#### In The Museum

Descendants of the 'almost martyr' Guillaume Coûture found valuable information in exhibits. Couture was a layman captured and tortured with St Isaac Jogues. He became an honorary member of the Mohawk tribe. He went on to raise a French-Canadian family of ten children.

The home parish of a family from India is named for St. René Goupil, Now living in NJ, the family took photos of the many images of the martyr to send to the parish. They were moved by their walk into the Ravine where the saint is buried.

Funeral director transporting a body for burial in Jesuit cemetery at Auriesville stopped at the museum. His hand was severely wrapped since severing tendons in a carpentry accident; He was awaiting surgery. He was not knowledgeable about the Martyrs or of the hand mutilations suffered by St. Isaac Jogues. Grateful that God had brought him here, he asked for prayers through the saint's intercession.
